Employees and volunteers must show an understanding of and commitment to equal opportunities. Training will be given where necessary. Evidence of discrimination by employees and volunteers will result in disciplinary action.

All literature produced by Campaign for Better Transport will use non-sexist and non-racist language and will fairly represent the gender and race balance in society.

Wherever possible, meetings organised by Campaign for Better Transport will be held in premises which are fully accessible.

All employees must accept personal responsibility for the practical application of this policy. The Board of Directors of Campaign for Better Transport Limited and the Trustees of Campaign for Better Transport Charitable Trust are ultimately responsible for carrying out and monitoring equal opportunities at Campaign for Better Transport.
